1. Scholarship Program Overview:

Total Quota:

- 20 scholarships for undergraduate and postgraduate training.
- 15 scholarships for short-term Khmer language courses.

Eligible fields of study (including but not limited to):

- Khmer Language and Culture
- Natural Sciences (Biology, Chemistry, Environment, etc.)
- Engineering and Technology (Information Technology, Telecommunications, etc.)
- Social Sciences & Humanities (History, Philosophy, Tourism, Psychology, Social Work, etc.)
- Languages (English, French, Chinese, Japanese, Korean, etc.)
- Management, Community Development, Education, etc.

Training Duration:

- Undergraduate: 05 years (including 1 year of Khmer language, if necessary)
- Master's: 03 years.
- PhD: 04 years.
- Khmer Language Training: 02 years.

Scholarship Benefits:

- Cambodian Side: Tuition fee waiver, dormitory accommodation.
- **Vietnamese Side:** Support for living expenses, travel expenses, passport, visa, health insurance, and round-trip airfare.

2. Eligibility and Application Requirements:

General Requirements:

- Good moral character and sufficient physical and mental health to study abroad.
- Commitment to completing the program and not changing major or institution after enrollment

Specific Criteria:

Undergraduate:

- High school graduates from 2023, 2024, 2025 with GPA of 6.5/10 or higher in grades 10–12
- o First-year university students with equivalent academic standing.

Master's:

- Must hold a bachelor's degree and be currently employed at a public institution or educational organization
- Must have at least 12 months of work contract and social insurance
- Not older than 40 years of age by July 31, 2025 (or 35 if previously studied undergraduate in Cambodia)

PhD:

- Must hold a master's degree and be currently employed at a public institution or educational organization
- Meet similar employment conditions as above.
- Not older than 40 years old (or 35 years old if having completed Master's studies in Cambodia).

Khmer Language Program:

- High school graduates or higher, currently working at a public institution or educational organization
- Ensure eligibility to work for at least 03 years from July 31, 2025.
