- Under 30 years old for PhD programs
- Under 40 years old for researchers/scholars

### • Language Proficiency:

o Minimum B2 level in Italian or English, depending on the chosen program

# 3. Scholarship Coverage

- Tuition fees: Full or partial waiver depending on the institution
- Monthly stipend: €900
- Health and medical insurance for the duration of the scholarship
- Funding duration: Up to 9 months for the academic year 2025–2026
